

Why is the black-white gap getting worse in 3rd grade?



Because the 3rd grade black-white gap in 2013 is bigger than the gap in 2012, something about our 3rd grade classrooms is making the black-white achievement gap worse.

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Follow a cohort of students through the district.



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
Student achievement (2013) = What I learned + Student achievement (2012)





4th Grade gap of 55% in 2013






